Substance Abuse Testing – Instructions and Collection Sites

- As part of your conditions of Supervised Release or Pretrial Supervision, you will be required to submit random urinalysis tests. These can be done, as directed by your supervising officer in the Probation Office, during field contacts, or at a contracted vendor location.
- If you are to provide urine specimens at a contracted vendor, you will be provided with UA instructions in your red/blue sign-up folder.
- You will be responsible for contact the UA phone message EVERYDAY (7 days/week, including holidays).
- You are to provide a valid urine specimen meaning they should not be diluted or adulterated.
 Providing a dilute or adulterated urine specimen is a violation of supervision and may be
 grounds for revocation of your supervision. It is STRONGLY encouraged you call the UA line
 early in the morning so you can monitor your fluid intake.
- If you are taking medication (over the counter or prescribed) you are required to bring the medication with you to every urinalysis test.
